On Thursday, July 2, 2020, Ann Kearney, loving Mother of 6 children passed away at age 81.

She worked at Child Protective Services for 16 years and as a CNA at Lima States until disability force her to take early retirement. She married Horace Davis in 1955 and shared 6 children. Her children meant the world to her. She was strict as a single mother but she did it with love. Even the neighborhood children loved her. She would feed them, bathe them, discipline them and then send them home to their parents. She states that one more child did not make a difference and treated us all as one! During her years as CPS, she would bring a child to the house that needed foster care overnight! That child knew that it was protected and had many brothers and sisters even for one night!

Ann E. Kearney was preceded in death by her mother Dorothy, father Percy, husband William (Sonny), sister Renee, daughter Regina, grandchildren Mike, J., and Brandon. She is survived by 5 children, Darlene (Jose), Horace, Cheryl (Mike), Melvin and Gale (Bevan) and two stepchildren Victoria Smith and Karen (Tina) Carey. She has 19 grandchildren and a host of great grandchildren and other relatives.
