Annie Mae Toogood, born to the late Hallie Ann Burwell in Townsville, North Carolina on January 2, 1930. Annie Mae passed away peacefully at home on Sunday morning May 18, 2025. She was the youngest of her siblings of four sisters, one brother and a nephew, Edward Burwell whom she always referred to as her brother. She was educated in the Townsville School system.

Annie Mae came to Chester in 1947 after the passing of her mother to live with her oldest sister and brother in law, Helen and William Brincefield. There she met and married the late Robert J. Toogood with whom they raised six children and one nephew, Brett Fryer.

Annie Mae enjoyed sitting on her porch talking with her neighbor Alberta Duncan and people waving to her as they passed by. Annie Mae was friends with everyone especially her lifelong best friend, Ms. Dorothy Dill. They would talk with each other every day. She also loved going to the Chester's Senior Center and being with her younger friends Valeria Hood-Curry and Renee Crews. There were also guy friends she would talk with while at the center. She had many, many friends and just loved everyone! Her favorite time was being spent with her daughters Robin and Pela and going with them to the casino.

Annie Mae was preceded in death by her mother Hallie Ann Burwell, all her siblings, daughter Margaret Ann Foreman and grandson Brion Lamar Toogood.
