



## Bertha Wright

March 4, 1949 - June 21, 2025

Bertha (Tolbert) Wright, daughter of Mike Tolbert and the late Elizabeth (Wilson) Tolbert Murray, was born in Allendale County in South Carolina on March 4, 1949.

Bertha was raised on the Groton Plantation in Allendale County, South Carolina. She attended the Fairfax Training School (Fairfax, S.C.) until the 9th grade. After high school she was united in marriage to Verdell Wright of South Carolina which was short-lived. She then moved to Media, Pennsylvania where she lived for many years. Bertha also resided in Chester, Pa. and Lansdowne, Pa., before moving into St. Francis Nursing Home in Darby, Pa. As a resident of St. Francis Nursing Home she participated in many of the facilities activities. This included graduating from a 5-part training program to become a Pennsylvania Empowered Expert Resident (PEER) allowing her to be a self-advocate and empower fellow residents to improve their quality of life and care in long term care facilities.

Bertha will be remembered as a caring person, willing to help when she could. She liked cooking, coloring, crafting and loved shopping for clothes.

Bertha Wright departed this life on Saturday, June 21, 2025 at the St. Francis Nursing Home in Darby, Pa. She was preceded in death by a brother, Mike Tolbert and a sister, Mamye (Tolbert) Fitzgerald who departed this life on the

same day.
