Betty Jean Staples was born on April 5, 1951 to the late Freddie Fleming, Jr and Cathy Lane Fleming in Greenwood, South Carolina. Her family migrated to Chester, PA when she was very young. Betty started to display her academic abilities early in her life.

Betty always excelled academically graduating from Chester High School in 1970. She continued to further her education at Delaware State University graduating with a Bachelor of Science in Sociology in June 1974. She pursued her education further by graduating from Bryn Mawr College with a Masters of Science Degree in Sociology in May 1976.

Out of this union a handsome baby boy was born on August 11, 1977 named Clifford Staples, Jr. (affectionately known as Little Skeet). Her happy family circle was her pride and joy.
