Buena Marie Miles (Morse) was born in Sparta, Georgia on August 21, 1934, to the late Willie H. Morse and Addie Lewis Morse. She peacefully transitioned to be with the Lord on April 16, 2024, at the age of 89.

Buena was raised and educated in Sparta, Georgia, graduating from L.S. Ingram High School in 1951. Buena met and married James Miles Sr. They spent many wonderful years together with their children, Brenda and Bruce.

In 1958, under Rev. L. J. Freeman, Buena joined Shiloh Baptist Church which at that time was located at 8th and Central Ave. She was immediately baptized and for the last 66 years, she served as a proud, consistent, and faithful member of Shiloh Baptist Church. At the age of 89, she would still attend church when she could, and was still involved with the Senior Ministry of her beloved Shiloh Baptist Church.

Buena worked at Scott Paper Company, and for the Postal Service system in Chester for a short time. However, in 1964, she became a teacher's assistant in the Chester Upland School District. She loved working with children and focused on making sure they not only learned their basic information, but that the students also understood the importance of respect and manners. She worked at various locations throughout the district and retired at the age of 70 after 40 years of service.
