Deborah (Debbie) Denise Coe, 62, a resident of Upland, Pennsylvania (PA), peacefully passed away on September 15, 2023, at the Lankenau Medical Center, Wynnewood, PA after a long illness.

Debbie was born in Philadelphia, PA on April 21, 1961, and was raised primarily in Morton, PA. She was the daughter of the late Daisy Mae (Greene) Coe and the late Judge L. Coe, Sr. She graduated from Springfield High School in Springfield, Delaware County, PA in 1979, and thereafter obtained a technical training certificate as a Secretary/Administrative Assistant. She then worked as an Administrative Assistant for the British Petroleum Company in Marcus Hook, PA. In or about 2003 she secured a position as an Adult Day Instructor at the Elwyn Institute, Media, PA. She provided supervision, guidance, instruction, and skill building services to adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities, and related behavioral health challenges, regarding daily living activities, safety, community inclusion, and interaction with others.

At an early age Debbie received Jesus Christ as her personal savior, and lived a life of devotion to the Lord until she was called Home. Deborah became a member of the Abounding Grace Family Worship Center on October 5, 1997. She fellowshiped with her many friends and acquaintances at the Center, currently located in Media, PA. She was a firm believer in Jesus Christ and a

longtime, active, and supportive member of the Center. Over the years of her membership, she participated on the Praise Team, was an Usher/Greeter, worked as a Children's Ministry helper, and was a faithful member in the Nursing Home ministry and Corporate Intercessory Prayer. In addition, she was a student in the School of the Warrior (training institute) and assisted in many other efforts and outreaches for the kingdom of God.

She was preceded to eternal rest by her father and mother, Judge L. Coe, Sr. and Daisy Mae Coe, and sister, Angela G. Coe Wiggins Carter. Debbie was blessed with and is survived by her daughter, Tamika Johnson, and grandson, Andrew S. Waters.
