The Life Story of Donald William Green

Deacon Donald William Green was born January 1, 1943 to the late Flora Green and William Green, at the Chester Hospital. Donald attended the Chester School District until the family relocated to Darby Township. He completed his education and graduated in Darby. He also attended the Berrien Institute where he honed his craft and became licensed as a barber. Donald was introduced to Christ at an early age, while attending Sunday School with his mother, at Mount Zion Church, in Sharon Hill. He later joined St. John Church in Chester, before becoming a member of Providence Baptist Church under the pastorate of Reverend Joel B. McGee. Donald became a deacon under Reverend McGee and he also served on the Usher Board and was a member of the Sarah Finley Male Chorus. Donald's favorite hymn was, "At the Cross" and his favorite Bible Verses were Psalms 37: 22-24 and Proverbs 3: 5-6. Donald served actively until his health began to fail, and even then he remained faithful and never complained.

Donald was self-employed for many years as a barber in West Chester, PA. He was also employed at the Scott Paper Company and Boeing Vertol, before retiring from Widener University, where he was a part time security guard. Donald loved going on vacation in Ocean City, Maryland during summers, with his family. He also loved visiting family in Omaha, Nebraska. Donald was an avid Eagles fan, as well. Most of all he loved being surrounded by family. Donald was married to his devoted wife, Valerie. Together they enjoyed

traveling, watching sports, and watching Wheel of Fortune on the television, as well as spending time with family and friends.

Donald was called home to Glory on August 8, 2023, with his wife by his side. He is preceded in death by his parents, John and Flora Beauford, his son Ronald Green, and his brother Neal Beauford.
