Mr. Edward Scott Godsey, affectionately known as "Scottie" of 1213 W 7th Street, Chester PA, departed this life Friday, November 9th at Christiana Hospital. He was born August 3rd, 1925 to the late Philmore Godsey and Mary Godsey in Dinwiddie County, Virginia.

Edward was the only son of eight siblings. He began his formal education in Dinwiddie County school system. He later served our country through Fort Bragg earning the American Theater Service medal, EAME service medal with bronze service, Asiatic Pacific service medal, Philippine liberation service medal, and World War II victory medal.
