On Wednesday, January 18, 2023, our Geraldine, Geri, G\$ (the name those close to her called her) quietly and peacefully went home to be with her beloved Jesus after a lengthy illness. She was 79 years old.

Geri was born on April 15, 1943, to the late Gracie Tucker Palm & the late Aza L Moorefield in Halifax, Va. She moved to Chester Pa in the 1950s where she resided until the last few months of her life.

She was a proud 1962 graduate of Chester High School. After graduation, she briefly attended

Chester Upland Practical Nursing School and later worked at Thomas Jefferson Hospital, Mercy Convalescent Nursing Home, and Chester Hospital. But it was at Crozer Chester Medical Center where the Lord used her mightily to wisely win souls for Him.

Crozer not only served as a place of employment but also a mission field for Jesus. The Lord used Geri to minister and lead many of her co-workers to the Lord. Many of them are working in the ministry today. In fact, the Lord laid upon Geri's heart to start her own ministry. She fought the assignment but after an encounter with food poisoning at the Baltimore Harbor, she relented

and started Christlike Mission in her basement. She ministered in her basement for 7 years until her beloved mother went home to be with the Lord.

Geri's desire to live for and follow Jesus came from not only the example set by her mother Prophetess Gracie Palm but also the teachings she received from Rev. Thea Jones at the Met. It was there where she received the foundation necessary to accomplish the mission at Crozer. It was at the Met where she made lifelong friends and family. She often talked about her time singing in the Met Choir and with Aunt Pastor Hazel Patrick and the Thea Jones Singers. Her children teased her about her singing, but Geri didn't care. All she ever wanted to do was sing for the Lord. That was Geri. Always striving to please the Lord.

In 2016, the Lord changed G's assignment and led her to join her daughter Lisa and DJ at Divine Liberty Ministries. She ministered, encouraged, prayed for and cut up with her church family. In 2019, G was ordained an Evangelist. Even though she had retired from Crozer 25 years prior, she still had a heart for winning souls for Jesus Christ on her new mission field.

In September 2022, after G received her diagnosis and prognosis, she expressed her desire to have a meeting with all of her loved ones to rededicate their lives to Christ. However, she did not have an opportunity to call that meeting herself. Instead, the Lord used her one last time at Accent Hospice in Christiana Hospital. G unknowingly conducted a four-day revival from her hospital room. Family, friends who visited her and staff that took care of her were saved, delivered, and made free. The Lord used her children and friends to minister and take up the mantle that she was leaving behind.

Geri was married twice to Carl R Wright, Sr (Sonny) and John E Cousin (Eddie). It was from these unions that her children, Lisa & Carl, were born AND she was blessed with love children.

G\$ is predeceased by her beloved mother, Prophetess Gracie Palm, her father Aza Moorefield, her stepfather, John Palm and her brother Arthur Moorefield.
