



## Juanita R. Robinson

August 20, 1942 - August 13, 2022

Mother Juanita Rose Robinson was born on August 20, 1942 to the late Lemwood and Rosie Pink Anderson, the youngest of three children. Mother Robinson was called to glory on August 13, 2022.

She was educated in the Chester Township Public School system and later attended Philadelphia Beauty School where she obtained a Cosmetology degree. Mother Robinson completed all requirements to become a licensed cosmetologist in the state of Pennsylvania. She later advanced to the level of instructor and ultimately became an entrepreneur where she successfully operated her salon for 37 years.

She was married to Dr. Joe L. Robinson who is the pastor of the Solid Rock Church of God in Christ and currently serves as Administrative Assistant to Bishop D. Screven, in the Eastern Jurisdiction of Pennsylvania, COGIC.

Mother Robinson's Christian roots began at an early age, raised, and nurtured by her parents. She attended various churches as a youth until she found a spiritual home at Range Temple COGIC where she was taught holiness by the late Bishop and Mother Cornelius D. Range, Sr. God used her in such capacities as editor of "Evangelist Speaks" newsletter, and announcer for Range Temple's radio broadcast ministry. Mother Robinson served in her local church as the Church Mother and Administrative Assistant of Solid Rock

Church where she was the First Lady. In addition, she started a Prayer Ministry in 2009 that meets twice weekly via a conference call line, praying for 30 minutes each call. Many souls were reached, healed, delivered, and encouraged through this prayer line. As president of Solid Rock's Prayer & Bible Band ministry, she instructed not only the women but also the brethren, what God requires of His people.

Being called to greater service for the Lord, she was licensed in August of 1986, as an Evangelist-missionary in the Church of God in Christ, in the Eastern Jurisdiction of Pennsylvania under the leadership of Bishop DeWitt A. Burton. Mother followed the leading of the Holy Spirit as she served in the Eastern Jurisdiction as an Evangelist Missionary, District Missionary, Chairlady of the Executive Board, Expeditor of Finances, and Assistant State Supervisor. She was appointed by Bishop Burton and served as the Supervisor of the Eastern Jurisdiction's Women's Department. She served as a member of the National Prayer Ministry.

Mother Robinson was a faithful wife, exemplifying Proverbs 31:10–12. She was a praying woman who believed God for everything. Mother Robinson taught the saints to do as Hebrews 12:14 says, "Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord." She lived an exemplary sanctified life, loved people, and loved serving the Lord.

Mother Robinson was preceded in death by her parents and her brother Jess Anderson. She leaves to cherish her memory her husband, Dr. Joe L. Robinson, brother, Lemuel Anderson, spiritual daughter, Louise Buckner whom she nurtured since childhood, the Solid Rock Church family, relatives, and a multitude of friends. Mother Robinson was saved, sanctified, Holy Ghost filled and served the Lord with gladness in her heart.
