Karen Joyce Warrick Blunt was born on October 8, 1952, the third of nine children to Maurice Edmund Warrick, Sr and Evelyn Dolores Bagby Warrick.

Karen was raised in a very special place known as Morton, PA. She attended Sidney Smedley School in Morton before graduating from Springfield High School, where she played intramural sports, served as a library and gymnasium student aide, and of course, spent three years as a member of the Future Business Leaders of America. After graduation, Karen married Michael Denny Blunt, Sr and enrolled at Cheyney University where she studied Business Administration. On her 21st birthday, Karen gave birth to her only child, Michael Denny Blunt, Jr.

With the birth of her son, Karen unenrolled from Cheyney University to shift her immediate focus onto her family; this also marked the next phase of her extraordinary journey. Karen entered the workforce which eventually led to her climbing the employment ladders at PECO (formerly Philadelphia Electric Co.) and Delaware County Courthouse, where she spent over a decade at each.
