When the teacher said jump in the pool, she did not hesitate! Malina fancied herself a "farmer" and loved planting a garden. Although she liked starting the garden, she left the harvesting to her mother. However, Malina particularly enjoyed sharing the "Big Boy" tomatoes with her neighbors. Malina loved to cook, and her macaroni and cheese rivaled that of her mother (so she said). She also liked making and selling crafts at flea markets. Malina was honored by the Chaplain of Four Chaplains for her volunteer work at the Red Cross.

Malina was predeceased by her husband, Solomon Carter and brother-in-law James Roper Jr.
