Deacon Michael Sudler passed away peacefully and leaves behind a legacy of lessons learned, love freely given and children marked forever by his guidance. Born of Chester, PA in 1942, Michael was baptized at 14 and graduated from Chester High in 1962. Shortly after graduation, he joined the United States Army and served his country with honor. Following his military service, Michael continued his education at Widener University, where he earned his degree and began building a life that would define him as a man of faith, strength and purpose. He married Judith K Morgan in 1980, beginning a partnership that shaped much of his adult life.

Michael was known for being a provider, teacher, and a man of strength and unwavering faith. He loved his family deeply and was often on the phone with them- encouraging, guiding and lifting up not only his children but also his nieces and nephews. He began his career after Widener at FMC and then moved on to Sun Pipe Line, where he held supervisory positions at both companies for many years.

Michael is lovingly survived by his son, Whitney; his daughters, Geraldine Riley and Robyn March; granddaughter: Jamera Williams, who brought him immeasurable joy.
