Mohammed Nasim Ahmed, affectionately known as Kim (a name given to him by his late Grandmother the late Eula Cruz Abrams) was the youngest of six children born to the late Marian Mercer Ahmed and Jamir Uddin Ahmed, on November 20, 1951.

After a lengthy illness, he was called to his heavenly home, Sunday evening September 26, 2021, at his residence, surrounded by his loving family.

Kim was educated in the Chester Upland School District graduating from Chester High School in June 1970.

After graduation, Kim worked several jobs, all of which were in Delaware County. He was most proud of being recognized as "Employee of the Month while working at Naamans Creek Nursing Home, a facility which he holds close to his heart. Kim retired from Covanta, Delaware Valley LP, Chester, PA, on October 15, 2015.
