He loved to be silly and could brighten anyone's day with his infectious smile. His humor was always elevated with a witty remark. He never failed to be the voice of reason for his friends, and the one person everyone could count on to shower them with love. Spending time with those he loved was important to him, and he would always let you know how much he cared about you. His charm and charisma will be deeply missed by all.

Nairee was educated in the Brandywine School District. He attended Hanby Elementary School, Springer Middle School, and Concord High School. At Springer Middle School, he was a member of the track and wrestling teams and sang on the chorus. For the past three years, Nairee attended Concord High School, Home of the Raiders. During his time as a Raider, he was a student-athlete, who played football, lacrosse, and wrestling team. In addition to academics and sports, Nairee served as a library aide and was a member of the Concord Chorale. Nairee enjoyed being a Concord Raider and always demonstrated school spirit.
