Her life Story

Norma Gans-Northington answered the call of the Master on January 31, 1922 while baking for her family at home. At the age of 89 she had no Dementia, nor Alzheimers. Although, she was challenged physically, mentally she was on point.

Norma was the 5th child of 18 siblings born to the late Henry and Thelma Gans on May 18, 1932.
